WITH THE RANK OF MAJOR.

Capt J. Clare of Co M, 5th Regt, MVM, Requests to be Retired.

HUDSON, Dec 2—Capt James P. Clare this morning forwarded to Boston his resignation as commander of Co M, 5th regt, MVM, with a request to be retired with the increased rank of major, to which he is entitled by his military record having served in the civil war and five years as a commissioned officer since that time.

The property of the company will be turned over to 1st Lieut Harry C. Moore until a successor to Capt Clare is elected.

Capt Clare will probably make his last appearance with the company on Tuesday evening at a smoke talk to be given at the armory, when he will talk on his experience with the 26th regulars in the Philippines.
