DECLARATION FOR PENSION.

THE PENSION CERTIFICATE SHOULD NOT BE FORWARDED WITH THE APPLICATION.

D. one thousand nine hundred and Twelve, personally appeared before me, a Justice of the Peace within and for the county and State aforesaid, Francis E Harris, who, being duly sworn according to law, declares that he is 68 years of age, and a resident of Acton county of Middlesex, State of Mass; and that he is the identical person who was ENROLLED at Larwell Mass under the name of Francis E Harris, on the 25th day of August, 1862, as a Corporal, in Co B 6 Reg Infantry Massachusetts

in the service of the United States, in the Civil war, and was HONORABLY DISCHARGED at Larwell, on the 30th day of June, 1863.
That he also served Co B 6 Reg Infantry Mass from July 8th 1864 to Oct 27th 1864
