3 to see if the town will except of an offer that Mr. Secumiah Emery of Chelmsford Designs to make to the town of Acton and not have his Lands that Lieth in the town of Acton and so warrant was Committed to the two Constables viz Jonathan Wheeler and Amos Prescott and the Inhabitants Did meet on the Day above sd

- All a General town meeting of the Inhabitants of the town of Acton Legally warned Licut John Heats was Chosen Moderator of sd meeting on the first article Propounded whether the town will Reconsider there vote that they will set there meeting house in the Centre voted on the affirmative Propounded whether they will set there meeting on the knowl first mentioned in the Warrant and where the Pine tree was marked In second Division Land of Docter Cuming voted on the affirmative
- 1 on the second article Propounded whether the town will begin to build a meeting house this year voted on the affirmative Propounded what Dimensions they would build it voted they would build it forty six feet Long and twenty and eight wide and twenty feet In height
  - 2 on the third article Propounded whether the town of Acton will free Mr. Secumiah Emery of all Past and future his Lands Poles and the Stele Ratable In all town Rates for 6 years of six year from of Date of this meeting
