W^{ch} beginning at y^e Line between William Pierce and William Conant
to a worked tree then to a Rock at y^e west End of y^e Conants house
then as y^e trees are marked through y^e Conants Land then turning Northwest
oak tree marked in Andrew Darbys Land then turning Northwest
and so by y^e Darbys way then to a black oak and so as y^e trees are mar-
ked to mark Whitts Land then southwesterly to a heap of stones then
turning North westerly and y^e way is on y^e Line between y^e Lots
y^e one Drawn by Ebenezer Davis of Concord y^e other by George Robben
y^e flow of Eaquell Part out of each Lot then leaving y^e Line on y^e
south to a white oak marked then a Cros y^e brook at y^e upper End
of the Rock above Rock meadow then to a white oak marked then
to a stake at y^e Corner of y^e way and so along y^e Line to be y^e
bound on y^e North side of y^e way then to a white oak then as y^e
trees are marked untill it cometh to y^e way that cometh
