Acton April ye 12<sup>th</sup> 1737

- at a Genral town meeting of ye Inhabitants of Acton At ye Hoop of Joseph Barners at take of ye Clerk In ye noon ye meeting being by an adjournment from morn of 29<sup>th</sup> 1737 Mr John Davis was moderator of ye meeting & Proposed on ye Remaining articles as folloeth viz on ye 3 article Proposed whether ye town wold Discontinue ye way that was Laid out from Littleton way to John Davis his land wold Voted that They wold Discontinue that article
- 4 Proposed whether or No ye Town wold Discontinue ye way that was Laid out over ye brook at ye Rock & agree to have the Go over ye Brook at or Near ye old ford way where it may be convenient Voted that they wold Not
- 5 It was Proposed whether or No ye Town wold Buyle a Bridge over ye Brook at or Near John Shapards & Joneses saw mill To accomodate Dr. Shapard: or Except of any Land by ye Select<sup>men</sup> of Acton over ye Brook or Pond Voted that they wold buyle a Bridge over ye Brook Betwixt ye mill afore sd
- 6 Proposed whether ye Town wold allowe Joseph Barners of ye Town to Have Nine pounds Seven Shillings & Six Pence oute of ye Town money It Being his Due for framing ye meeting Hoop Voted on ye affirmative
- 7 Proposed whether ye Town wold Except of Two ways Laid out by ye Select men of Acton In ye year 1736 One way was made appear that one was Laid out for to accomodate Gory Roblins of Stow which way was Laid out June ye 22<sup>th</sup> of ye Voted in ye Affirmative. The way was Described as folloeth viz Beginning on ye wast side of ye Brook from Mr Gorys Land So across ye Brook by a Heap of Stones on ye East side & Way so on to a Stake & Stones & So to ye South East of Jim Hints hall to ye way that was Laid out by ye Select men of Concord To way to be two Rods wide

The other was Laid out by ye Select men of Acton August ye 17<sup>th</sup> of 1736 as was made appear at ye meeting To accomodate Mr John Davis of Acton & Voted in ye affirmative: A way was Described as folloeth viz Beginning at a Gray oak marked where Connants & Jarces way (up to Jarces then to a white oak then to a white oak then to a Gray oak then to a ~~white oak~~ walnut then to a black oak & So to ye Line betwixt the towns of Concord & Acton & So on ye Line to Groton Road ye bound on ye South side of ye Road
