 Jonathan Balls in Concord & pursuant to the notes of ye Towns Paid
 in march last past & find mutually agree that ye Cost of ye maintenance
 of ye widow Eliza Bath Sheperd for ye Acton one third parts thereof
 and that ye selectmen or overseers of ye Town of each towns afford from
 time to time shall have ye Care & Inspection of ye said widow

Acton October ye 13th 1737

The select men meet & appointed a town meeting to be on Monday ye
 fourth day of October at ye meeting house in Acton on ye articles following viz
 to see if ye town shall have their meeting house Precentory & Chape a Committee
 to be set out to work supply ye helpit alls when they will meet
 to see if ye town will Glaze their meeting house & Chape a Committee to
 set out to work
 to see if ye town will Chape a Committee to see ye accounts with ye town
 Treasurer

To see if ye town will pay Cot Josephs aright three pounds four shillings
 out of ye tax money
 to see what they will do about Beardshead Green Befored to this
 and ye same was Counted with their warrants to ye Constables to warn
 ye town to meet as aforesaid

Acton October ye 24th 1737

at a Gabriel town meeting of ye town agreed at ye meeting house mt
 Thomas Wheeler was made Rater of ye meeting & proceeded on ye articles
 as followeth viz
 to see if ye town will agree to have Precentory voted in ye alternative Propo
 whether they will Chape a Committee to supply ye helpit voted that ye select men
 should be a Committee for that purpose alls voted they will Begin ye first sub
 in January Next to meet
