Acton January ye 20th 1737/8

The select men met & Appointed a town meeting to be on
 Wednesday ye Twenty fifth Day of January for ye
 meeting House in ye town on ye affairs as folloeth viz
 1 To see what money ye town will Raise for Glazing their
 meeting House alls what money ye town will Raise to
 support Preaching as alls how ye town would pay and support
 Fletcher for providing a Caphary for ye pulpit alls
 how ye town would provide to Bullame accounts
 for setting up ye meeting House frame

Acton January ye 25th 1737

At a General town meeting Being legally was out of
 The Inhabitants of ye town aforesd at ye meeting House
 in ye town Mr Joseph Fletcher was Chosen moderator
 for ye meeting & Proceeded on ye articles as folloeth viz
 1 To see what money ye town would Raise for Glazing their
 meeting House voted they would Raise thirty Pounds
 2 To see what money ye town will Raise to support Pre
 voted they will Raise fifty Pounds
 3 To see how they will pay Mr Joseph Fletcher for ye pulpit
 voted that he shall have it out of ye Town money
 4 To see which way ye town will provide to Bullard acc
 up to for setting up ye meeting House frame voted that
 Comite that was Chosen to receive ye accounts viz viz
 Mr Samuell Prescott and John Brooks and mark while ben
 povered to receive & send a just accounts al or before ye
 the fifteenth Day of February Next on yeing of ye
 my hands & signet

Acton February ye 26th 1737/8

To an order to Enoch Cleveland for two pounds & seven teen
 shillings out of ye town money for reception of ye town
 In full from ye Dist of Grimsditch to ye health of this part
 Acton Feb. 26th 1737/8
 To an order to Nathan Robb for one pound out of ye
 Towns money for a living Place due from ye town
 to Mr Timothy minor for fiftish shillings out of ye town money
 for Green
