 the clock in ye fore noon to consider on ye Articles hereafter viz.
- 1 to Chuse town officers for ye year in lining
 - 2 to se off ye town with Discontinues a bit of way leading
 from the North west Corner of marsh white house lot as his fence
 Run towards Brabrook as may be shewn at D meeting
 - 3 to se off ye town with Discontinues a Bit of way leading
 from Joseph Barnes to ye meeting House formerly laid
 out as may be shewn at D meeting & Except of a way
 as now laid out as may be shewn at D meeting
 - 4 to se off ye town with Except of a way laid out by ye select
 men at ye Request of Josiah Piper to go to meeting as may
 be shewn at D meeting
 - 5 to se off the town with their Request of Joseph Barnes
 Relating to ye meeting House.
 - 6 to se off ye town with Lay out ~~ye~~ of the their New Gods
 in the meeting House in support of ye same as do any other
 thing Relating to that affair
