Then the select men met & appointed a town meeting to be at the meeting House in said town on <sup>Monday</sup> the 22<sup>nd</sup> of November current at ten of the Clock in ye fore Noon to conclude on the Articles here after mentioned viz first to Chuse a Constable in the stead of Jonathan Knight & to Chuse officers to inspect the Deer 3 to hear ye Request of a number of Littleton peti<sup>o</sup>rs 4 to see if ye town will Receive a vote that passed on the twenty third of may last Concerning ye Pews or Pews Ground 5 to see if ye town will Allow Mr Samuel Prescott & Amos Prescott to Draw but one Pew on both their Estates where as they might Draw two According to vote 6 to see if ye town will send John Davis to Draw a Pew notwithstanding ye vote passed at ye last meeting 7 to see if ye town will Chuse a Committee to Adjust Accounts with ye former Treasurer Mr John Berker: 8 to see if ye town will Chuse or Impower men to prosecute such persons as Refuse to pay their Province taxes & upon them a Lib<sup>er</sup>ty to Draw out of ye towns money to Carry on said affare if need be 9 to hear ye Report of the Committee that was Chosen to see who should Draw ye Pews as all so Pass or Confirm any other vote that may be thought proper when met Relating to that affare

at a General town meeting being legally warned as appeared by ye Return of ye Constables warrant at the meeting House in said town met & made ~~choice~~ choice of Mr Gershom Davis moderator for said meeting & proposed as followeth viz first Chose Mr Hierakiah Wheeler Constable in ye Room of Jonathan Knight & Chose Mr Jonathan Wheeler & Mr Samuel Jones to inspect ye Deer 3 propounded whether ye town will Receive Littleton Petitioners voted in ye affirmative 4 Propounded whether ye town will Receive their vote Relating ye Pews or Pew Ground & it passed in ye Negative Partide was dismissed 5 the sixth article was Read & disputed and ye night Draw on ye meeting <sup>was</sup> Adjourned to ye 30<sup>th</sup> of December next at ye meeting House in said town at one of ye Clock in ye after Noon.
