- 2 to See if ye town would have a movinge Schoole to Instruct ye youth in Reading & Righting ye present year
- 3 to See if ye town will agree to have those men that enjoy ye privileige of peas Rated for there privileige
- 4 to See if the town will Agree to Sell ye peas Ground that is not yett Buill upon to ye highest Bidders as allso Chuse a Committe to manage that affare
- 5 to See if ye town will agree to finish their meeting house and Chuse a Committe to manage it affare
- 6 to See if ye town will Let ye Swin run at Large <sup>Cyear</sup> of present and the Same was Commeted to the Constables
