November ye 23: 1744

at a general Town meeting at the meeting
House in said Town it being legally warned
as appeared by the returns of the Constables
on their warrant, Mr John Brooks was chosen
moderator for said meeting and proceeded as follows

Dismissed
- 2 the second article relating to the pews was
refer'd to the next meeting
- 3 propounded whether the Town will abate
