9 proposed whether that Mr Jonathan Billing and Mr Andrew Darby and Mr Daniel Fletcher be a Committee to adjust Accounts with the Committee that was Chosen to finish the Inside of the meeting House voted on the affirmative and then the meeting was dismissed

Acton November 3: 1747

Taken up and proceeded with as Strays by Amos project of Acton Three young Cattle one a Red Heifer supposed to be Comming in four years old with a white face and tail and Some white on her back and white belly and her hind feet white and Some white on her fore Legs branded on her Near Horn with the Letters O S G and an old Brand on the off horn worn out The others Two then supposed to be Comming in two years old one a Black one with Some white on his face and by his mouth and belly and Some white on his tail and Some on the Inside of each Gambrel and the top of the Near Ear Cut off and a Slit on the under Side and a half penny Cut out of the under Side of the off Ear the other a Brown one and hath no artificial mark

To an order to End month White for twenty nine pounds eight Shillings old tenor for Subscribing the widow Bradbrook from the first day of December 1746 until this day the whole of his Demands
