Then we the Subscribers Laid out a way from Littleton Line to Mrs Gattles place where Mrs Allen now Dwells Beginning at Littleton Line at a heap of Stones where Littleton left there Road then to a heap of Stones in Daniel Brooks Land then to a walnut tree then to a heap of Stones on a Rock then to the Stone wall and by the wall to Mrs Dippers Land the one half in Mrs Dippers Land the other half in Mrs Brooks Land to a heap of Stones in Mrs Simon Gattles Land then to a Black oak then to a white oak then to a heap of Stones and So to the Road that Leads from Mrs Allen to the meeting House Said way is two Rods wide and the marks are on the Easterly Side of Said way

Being Notified By the Select men of Concord to ^{behold} ~~renew~~ the Bounds Between Concord and Acton Messrs Abisgai Brown Stephen Hofner Jun and Ephraim Jones of Concord Leally appear from Concord and Messrs John Cragin Samuel Jones and Daniel Fletcher Legally appeared from Acton at the House of Mrs Joseph Hayward on Monday the sixteenth day of April and did Joyn and did Renew the Bound marks from Sudbury Corner to the Elm Stump by Mrs John Paslin and then Concord Refused to Renew any farther

and then June ye 4: 1753 Being Notified again by the Select men of Concord to meet them in order to Run the Line through and accordingly Mrs John Cragin and Mrs Daniel Fletcher and Jonathan Hofner from Acton did meet Messrs Abisgai Brown and David Paslin appointed by the Select men of Concord on June ye 7 1753 at the House of Mrs John Paslin in said Concord and did Renew the Bounds from the Elm Stump afore said and the first mark Renewed was a Stump and Stones on its head the widows Heals Barn and then a pitch pine tree marked and then a white oak tree marked at Pillsbury Line Commonly Called Berry Corner
