Whereas we the Subscribers Being Appointed a Committee to State the price of the Necessaries of Life at the Time of the Rev^d Mr Swifts Settlement among us and Accordingly we have According to our Best Information found the price as they was Sold in this and the Neighbouring Towns to be as follows (viz)

Indian Corn Thirty Bushels at Six Shillings per Bushel
Twenty Bushels of Rice at ten Shillings per Bushel
Five Hundred weights of pork at Eight pence per pound
Three Hundred weights of Beefe at five pence per pound
Twenty five pound of Sheeps wool at three Shilling and Six pence per pound
Fifteen pound of Cotton wool at four Shillings and Six pence per pound
fifty pound of flax at one Shilling and three pence per pound
Sugar fifty Six pound at one Shilling and four pence per pound
Twenty Gallons of Rum at Eight Shillings per Gallon
Eighty weight of Butter at one Shilling and four pence per pound
Two Hats at three pounds per Hat
One pair of Shoes at fifteen Shillings per pair
