at the Desire of John Parker Jun^r wth the Subscriber met and Renewed the
Bound between said Parker and Littleton Road the old Bound being
Lost and begun as followeth first at a small white oak marked at
the End of Mr Joseph Wooley's wall from thence to a heap of
Stones by the side of the Road that is removed from thence to a
heap of Stone on a Rock about three or four Yards from said Parker's
House Northwesterly from thence to a heap of Stones by the mill
Dick then they will Dick to be the Bound till it comes near to the
Mill from thence to a pine tree marked near Mr Parker's southeasterly
line and the marks are on the westerly side of said way.
