DECLARATION FOR PENSION.

THE PENSION CERTIFICATE SHOULD NOT BE FORWARDED WITH THE APPLICATION.

On this 26th day of February, A. D. one thousand nine hundred and seven, personally appeared before me, a Justice of the Peace within and for the county and State aforesaid, Warren B. Ball, who, being duly sworn according to law, declares that he is 77 years of age, and a resident of Maynard county of Middlesex, State of Massachusetts; and that he is the identical person who was ENROLLED at Concord, Mass. under the name of Warren B. Ball, on the 19th day of April, 1861, as a Private, in Company G, Fifth Regiment, Mass. Vol. Militia.

in the service of the United States, in the Civil war, and was HONORABLY DISCHARGED at Boston, Mass., on the 31st day of July, 1861. That he also served nine months more, reenlisted in same Company G and was transferred to 47th Regiment, Mass. Vol. Has made a Corporal Dec 10-1861. Can't find discharge papers. That he was not employed in the military or naval service of the United States otherwise than as stated above. That his personal description at enlistment was as follows: Height, 5 feet 4 1/2 inches; complexion, light; color of eyes, light; color of hair, Auburn; that his occupation was harness maker; that he was born December 27th, 1829, at Lowell, Mass.

That his several places of residence since leaving the service have been as follows: Concord, Mass. for a few months; Boston, Mass. until about 1888, and since that time in Maynard, Mass.

That he is a pensioner. That he has heretofore applied for pension Certificate number 1,045,984

That he makes this declaration for the purpose of being placed on the pension roll of the United States under the provisions of the act of February 6, 1907.

That his post-office address is Maynard, county of Middlesex, State of Massachusetts

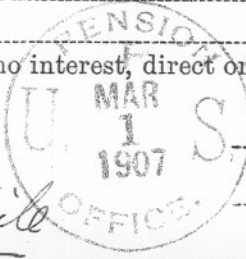
