DECLARATION FOR PENSION.

On this 20th day of May, A. D. one thousand nine hundred and twelve, personally appeared before me, a Notary Public within and for the county and State aforesaid, Horace E. Dupee who, being duly sworn according to law, declares that he is 78 years of age, and a resident of Fayborough county of Norfolk State of Mass; and that he is the identical person who was ENROLLED at Readville Mass under the name of Horace E. Dupee, on the 23d day of September, 1861 as a Private, in Co. B. Indpt. Battalion Mass. Cav. 1st Regt.

in the service of the United States, in the Civil war, and was HONORABLY DISCHARGED at Beaufort S.C. (State name of war, Civil or Mexican.)

That he also served in Co. K. 4th Regt. Mass. Cav. on the 31st day of December, 1863 in Co. K. 4th Regt. Mass. Cav. being enrolled in January 1, 1864 and was discharged on the 14th day of November 1865 at Richmond Va. end of war

That his personal description at enlistment was as follows: Height, 5 feet 4 1/2 inches; complexion, dark; color of eyes, blue; color of hair, brown; that his occupation was Shoemaker - 5 ordin; that he was born August 29th, 1833, at Medway Mass.

That his several places of residence since leaving the service have been as follows: Norfolk about 7 years, Norwood about 20 yrs, Fayborough since all in Massachusetts
