since

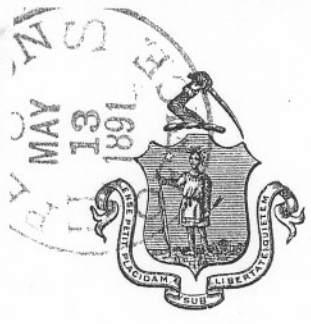
I further declare that I have no interest in said case, and am not concerned
