

ACT OF FEBRUARY 6, 1907.

DECLARATION FOR PENSION.

THE PENSION CERTIFICATE SHOULD NOT BE FORWARDED WITH THE APPLICATION.

State of Massachusetts }
County of Middlesex } ss.

On this 10th day of November, A. D. one thousand nine hundred and ten, personally appeared before me, a Justice of the Peace within and for the County and State aforesaid, William F. Hall, who, being duly sworn according to law, declares that he is 70 years of age, and a resident of Hudson County of Middlesex, State of Massachusetts; and that he is the identical person who was ENROLLED at Westford Mass under the name of William F. Hall, on the 25th day of August, 1862, as a Private, in Company E, 6th Reg of Infantry M. V. 444 (Here state rank, and company and regiment in the Army, or vessels if in the Navy.) in the service of the United States, in the Civil war, and was HONORABLY DISCHARGED at Lowell Mass, on the 3rd day of June, 1867. That he also served (Here give a complete statement of all other services, if any.)

That he was not employed in the military or naval service of the United States otherwise than as stated above. That his personal description at enlistment was as follows: Height, 5 feet 6 inches; complexion fair; color of eyes, hazel; color of hair, Light-brown; that his occupation was Farmer; that he was born November 7th, 1840, at Acton Massachusetts

That his several places of residence since leaving the service have been as follows: Stow Mass moved to Feltonville November 1865, moved to Stow Mass in 1865, then moved to Hudson Mass (State date of each change, as nearly as possible.)

That he is a pensioner. That he has heretofore applied for pension Pension certificate No 1080205 (If a pensioner, the certificate number only need be given. If not, give the number of the former application, if one was made.)

That he makes this declaration for the purpose of being placed on the pension roll of the United States under the provisions of the act of February 6, 1907.

That his post-office address is Hudson, County of Middlesex, State of Massachusetts. William F. Hall (Claimant's signature in full.)

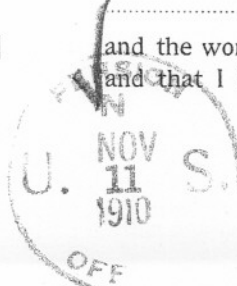
