This has reference to your latter dated February 6, 1941 wherein you refer to availability of any funds which might be applicable for payment on burial expenses of \$250.00 in the case of Mrs. Hamah A. Jones, Civil War widow beneficiary who died January 24, 1941.

According to the records, the only amount which may be available for payment toward the expenses of the decedent's last illness and burial would be the pension accruing from December 31, 1940, date of last payment, to January 24, 1941, alleged date of death, at the rate of \$40.00 per month.

This amount (although not an asset of the estate and not payable to heirs nor to an administrator or executor as such and not liable for payment of debts) may, under certain conditions, be paid to the person who bore the expenses of last illness and burial or who is held responsible therefor, in the event decedent is not survived by a child under sixteen years of age and did not leave sufficient assets to meet such expenses.

If it is desired to file claim for any accrued amount payable in this case, the enclosed Form 5036 may be completed by the proper person as determined by the facts and in accordance with printed instructions.

If claim is filed, same should be supported by bills covering all expenses of last illness and burial, properly receipted if paid, to show sources of payment, or if unpaid, each bill should show over the signature of the creditor the name of the person held responsible for payment; all bills to show name of decedent on whose account the services were furnished. There will also be required copy of public record of pensioners adeath certified as a true copy over the signature of the custodian of the public death records.
