# State of Vermont.

I, Lucius A. Hesselton of Canundish, Vt.,  
born in Canundish, Vt. aged 18 years + 3  
months and by occupation a Farmer do hereby voluntarily enlist,  
this 15<sup>th</sup> day of August A. D. 1864, as a soldier, for the  
term of one year unless sooner discharged by competent authority, in a Regiment of  
Infantry Volunteers, raised in the State of Vermont, to serve in the army of the United  
States; I do also agree to accept such bounty, pay, rations and clothing, as are, or  
may be established by law. And I do solemnly swear, that I will bear true faith and  
allegiance to the United States, that I will serve them honestly and faithfully against all  
their enemies and opposers whomsoever; and that I will observe and obey the orders of the  
President of the United States, and the orders of the officers appointed over me, according  
to the rules and articles of war and the regulations which govern enlisted men.
