- At a General Town meeting being Legally warned as as appeared by ye Returns of ye Constables Lth John Heald was Chosen Moderator of ye meeting & Proceeded on ye affairs hereafter mentioned & Propounded whether ye town will Purchase a Boiling Place Laid out by ye select men being in Possession of North Robbins voted in ye affirmative
- 2 Propounded whether ye town will Raise any money to defray for Charges this Present year voted they would. Receipt £15-0-0
 - 3 It was Propounded what money they would Raise towards finishing the meeting House this Present year. voted they would Raise one Hundred Pounds towards ye Payments agreed on by ye Committee to see ye work out. Lth John Heald & Jonathan Wheeler entered there ^{that} ye same
 - 4 Propounded what ye town will do Relating to Green: voted they will Refer that affare until ye Next town meeting
 - 5 Propounded whether ye town will pint ye underpinning of ye meeting House voted in ye affirmative & at ye same time Laid out ye work to Jonathan Bickings to do for ye sum of £2-50-0 which work he ^{is engaged} to do Spedley & To ye wheel
 - 6 It was Propounded whether ye town will Reconside their former vote that they will underpin this meeting house by working Each man a day and pay it by a Rate as also what they will allow Each man that it work at ye same vote that they will it paid that as usual. Provided that those that will Delinquent at ye meeting house on ye day appointed to work & work one day Each man at a shop or place by order of ye surveyor more than three Eggsel Part otherwise work have bin. Then ye meeting was dissolved
