When the Select. men met, and appointed a town meeting to be at the meeting House on Monday the fourth Day of March Next at the Consensus of the Clock to Consider and Conclude on the following articles (viz)

- 1 To Chuse Town officers for the year Enspring
- 2 To See if the town will Reconfer their vote upon the last march meeting Relating to the Bridle way by the Forge through John Barker Juns Land as also to See if the Town will creept of an open way Laid out by the Select. men from m^r John Barker Land through Ens mark Whites Land till it comes to the Road Leading from Deacon Brookes to the meeting House and from Said Road through Land now in the possession of Joseph Robbins and ~~from~~ John Barker Juns Land to Littleton Road — according to the ~~Return of Land~~ marks mentioned in the Returns of Said ways
- 3 To See if the Town will creept of away Land out to accommodate m^r Faulkner and m^r John Adams through m^r Faulkners Land according to the Return of Said way
- 4 To See if the Town will agree to Chuse a Comitt^{ee} to take Care of the timber that grows in the high ways in Said town that it may not be destroyed.
- 5 To See if the Town will agree to Let the Swine Run at Large this present year and the same was Comitted ~~to the~~ the Constables
