Then the Select men met and appointed a Town meeting to be at the meeting House on the first Monday of March Next at one of the Clock in the afternoon to Consider and Conclude on the following articles (viz.)

- 1 To Chuse Town officers for the year ensuing
- 2 To See if the Town will accept of a short ~~cut~~ way to accomodate the Heirs of Capt. of good Late of Acton Deceased Beginning at the Corner of said offgoods farm at a heap of Stones and then straight to the Corner of Mr Josiah Pipes fence at the Red Mr Swifts Road Said way is on the South side of said heap of Stones and is two Rods wide and said way is partly on the Red Mr Swifts Land and partly on Mr Josiah Pipes Land
- 3 To See if the Town will abate the Ministers Rate of Mr Joseph Temple and Mr Samuel Ober for the year past by Reason of their Supporting the preaching of the Gospel other where
- 4 To See if the Town will agree to Let the wine Run at Large this present year and the same was Committed to the Constables

at a General Town meeting at the meeting House it being Legally warned as appeared by the Returns of the Constables on their warrants and proceed as follows Capt. Fletcher was Chosen Moderator for said meeting and Jonathan Hoffman was Chosen Town Clerk and first Select man and Mr Stephen Law was ^{Chosen} Constable for the South west part of the Town and Mr Samson Wheeler was Chosen Constable for the North east part of the Town and Mr John Neal was Chosen the second Select man and Mr Francis Faulkner was Chosen the third Select man and the Select men was Chosen Assessors
